

## Pathway to Employment

The programme will help long-term unemployed people get the skills and work experience they need to help them access employment opportunities in the manufacturing and renewable sector. The first step towards getting onto the programme is to attend an assessment day at The Hub.

### What's involved?

- Assessment day
- Five week training programme
- Five week work placement with a local business
- Course designed for the manufacturing/renewable sector
- Candidates will be paid for 35 hours per week at National Minimum Wage

### What next?

- Book your place on an assessment day. This can be done through your Jobcentre Plus work coach or by phoning The Hub
- Assessment day results will be used to identify suitable candidates for the Pathway to Employment programme
